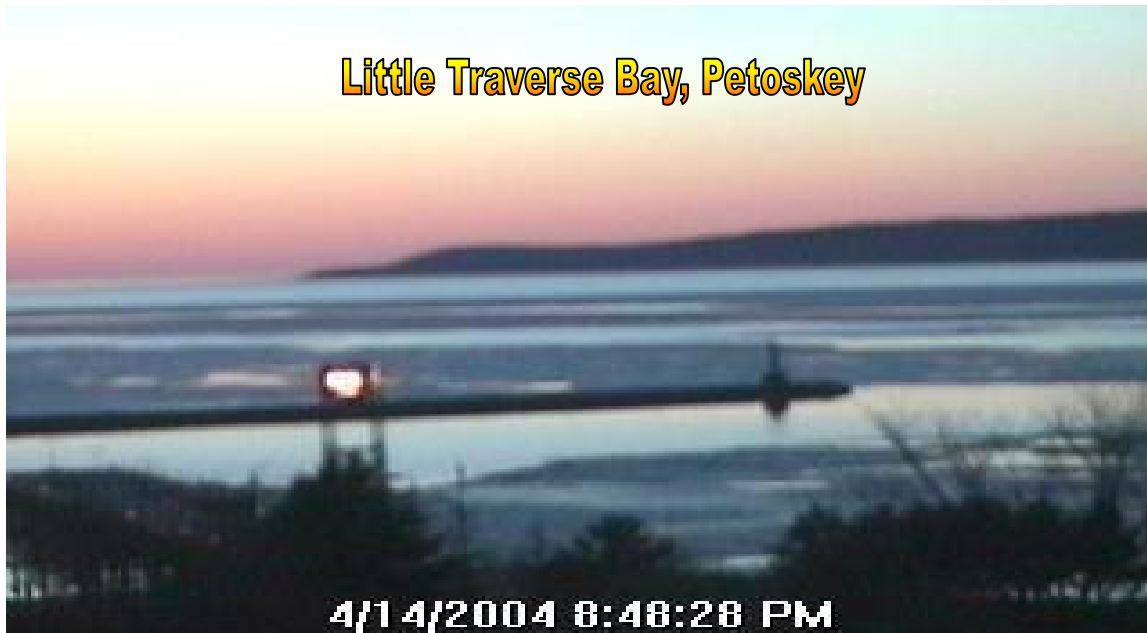

Petoskey is a school district of approximately 17,000 people located on Little Traverse Bay in the northwestern section of the Lower Peninsula of Michigan, 40 miles south of the Mackinac Bridge. Each season brings large number of tourists to the area to enjoy swimming, boating, fishing, golfing, hunting, skiing, snowmobiling, and tennis. Exclusive summer shops in Petoskey's famous "Gaslight District", outdoor art festivals, and concerts sponsored by the summer colony of Bay View are also among Petoskey's many attractions.

Continuing educational opportunities are available through adult and community education programs offered by the public schools, through North Central Michigan College (located in Petoskey), and through extension courses offered by major universities in Michigan.
