

Spanish Class Participation Points

Each student will receive **100** participation points per marking period. It is your responsibility to earn these points by doing the following:

- Be in your assigned seats when the bell rings so we can begin class on time.
- Have the materials that you need for class (book, notebook, pen or pencil, homework).
- Do not bring other materials that you do not need and will keep you from participating (music players, cell phones, work from other classes, etc.).
- Only have out what you need for class.
- Do the assignments that you are given in class at the time that they are assigned (don't start it five minutes after I ask you to do it).
- Don't talk to other students while I am teaching (It will cost both of you points).
- Actively participate in the activities we do in class (Don't sit and socialize with your friend during a group activity, etc.).
- Leave your area clean for the next class.

Making up participation points

If you are not participating in class, (you have your iPod out, you are working on other homework, etc.) you will receive a deduction of **5** points per incident. Participation points can be made up by writing a 100 word story in Spanish. It must be an original story, handwritten, using the vocabulary that we are learning in class. I have the right to accept a story as written or return it to you for a rewrite. Each story will be worth **5** points, however, you can only submit a story for make-up points twice each marking period, in other words, you can only make up 10 points of participation per marking period.
