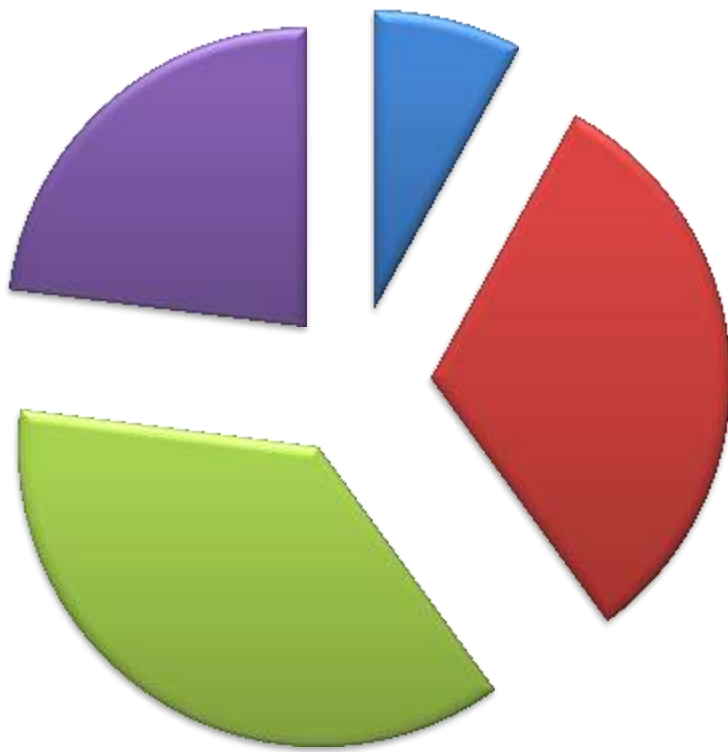


Which of the following best describes your use of the PHS handbook supplied at orientations, online and in the school office?



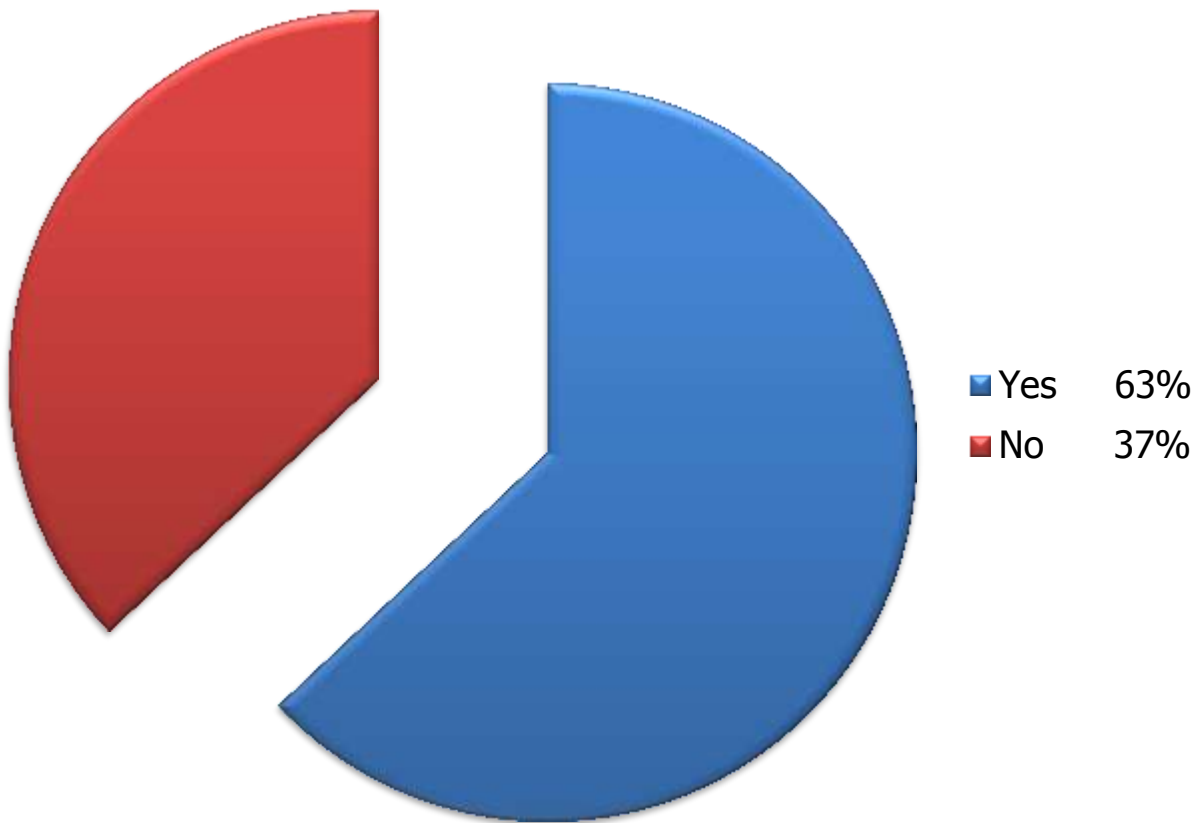
■ A: I have never seen nor read the school handbook. 8%

■ B: I only read the school handbook if there's something specific I need to reference. 32%

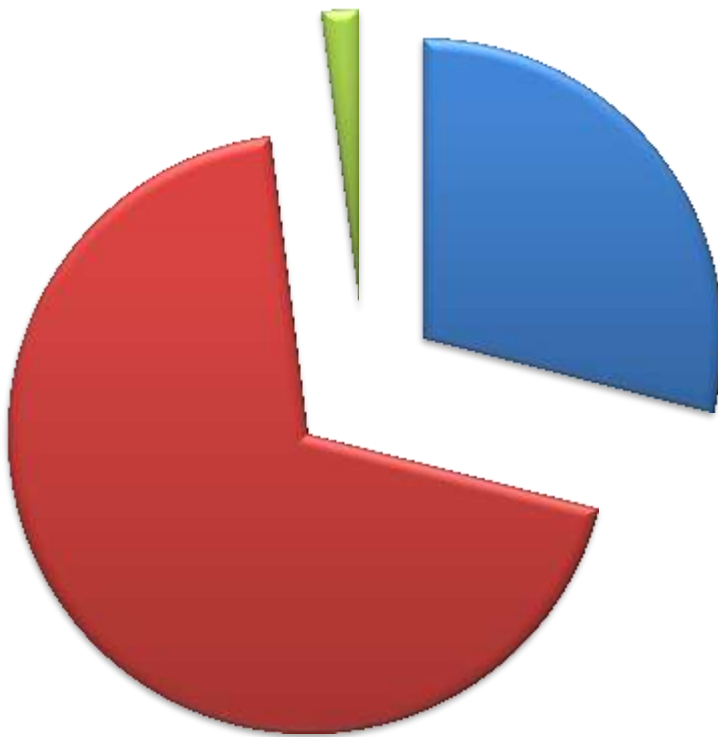
■ C: I read the parts of the school handbook I feel are important at the start of the year. 37%

What is your awareness level of school activity by-laws or rules?



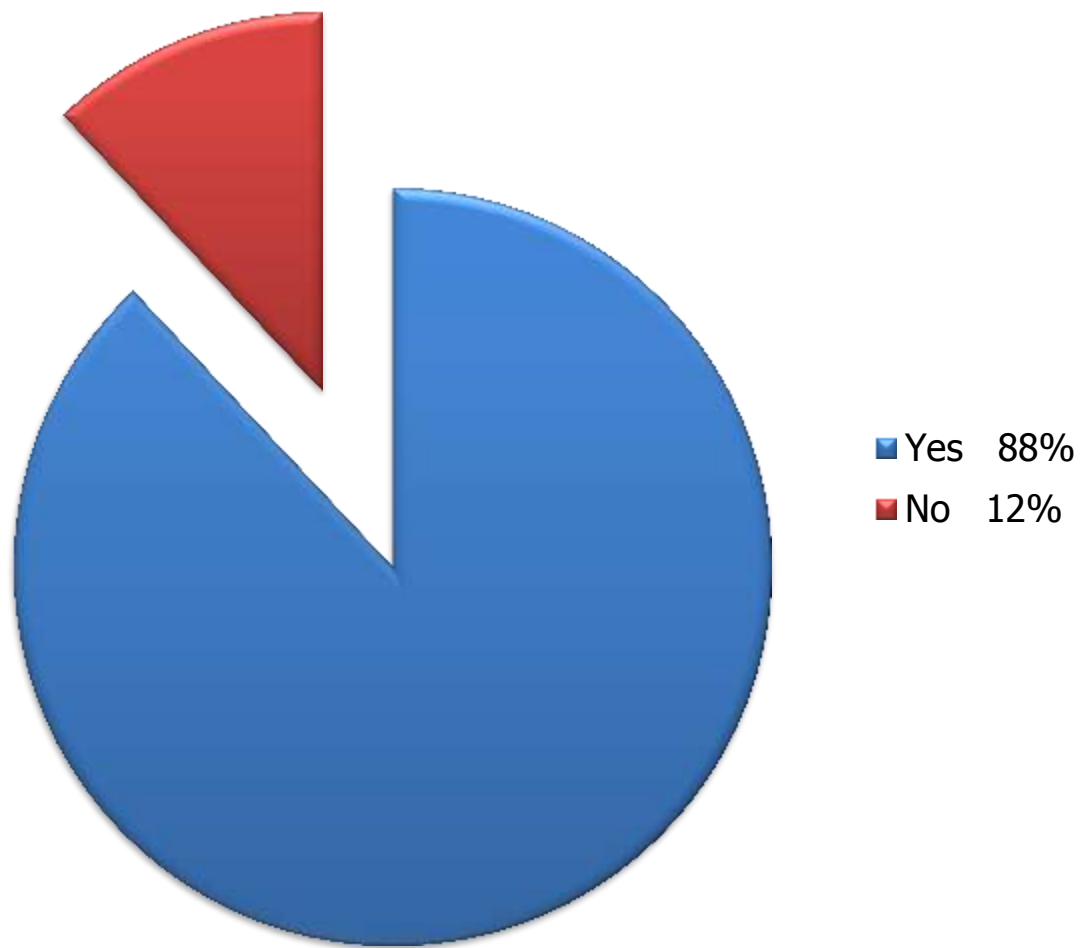
■ A: I rely on my child to know the by-laws or rules of each activity he/she participates in and am not interested in having this information as a parent. 12%

■ B: I know by-laws and rules exist for activities my child participates in but do not know what the specific rules are. 39%

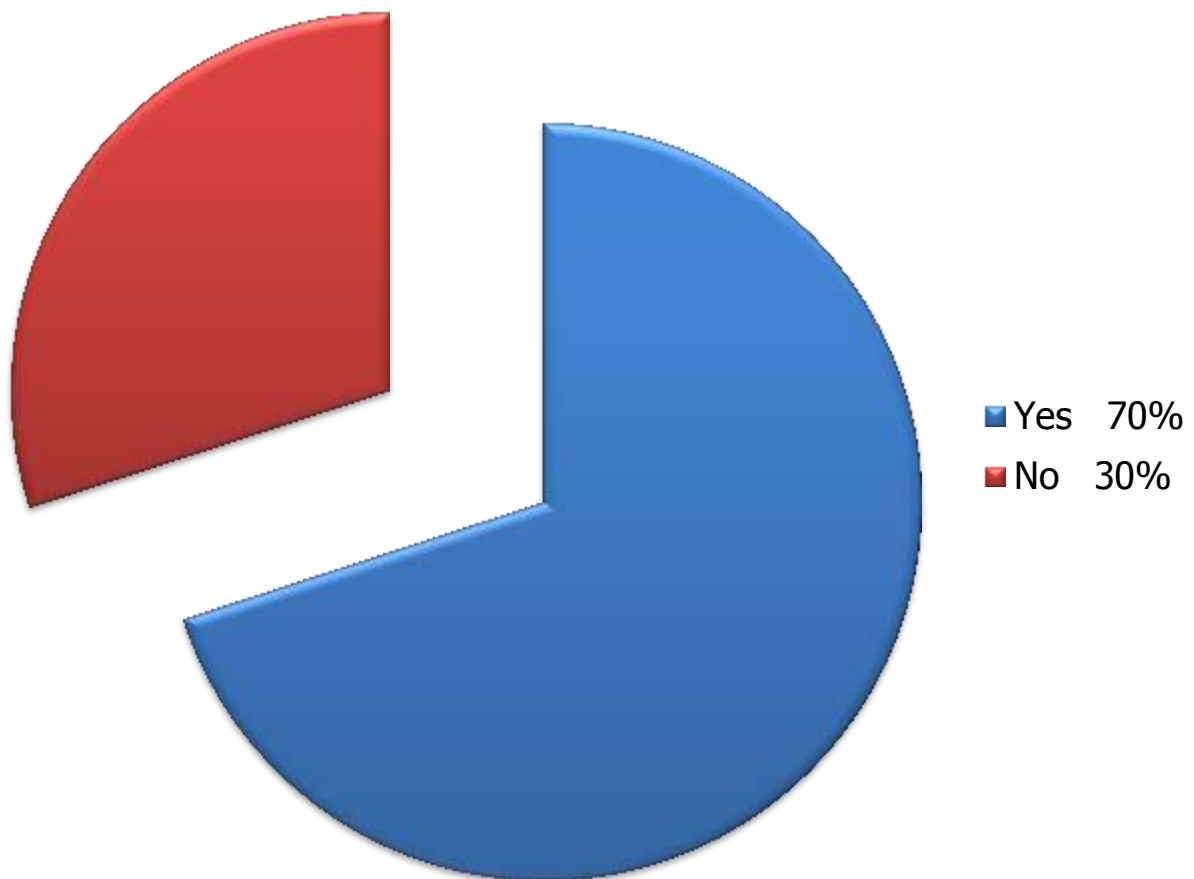
■ C: I have been provided a copy of the by-laws or rules of activities my child participates in. 23%
