Welcome to 2022! I hope that you all had wonderful winter breaks. Please do continue to keep your child home if they are not feeling well. This helps us to keep students and staff healthy and to keep school in session.

Students and staff are getting right back into the swing of things at Ottawa. We continue to encourage and celebrate 'lightbulb moments' and shining effort in all content areas. Students are learning how to persuade, include details or evidence to support their thinking, learn about celebrations around the world, and apply the use of math facts to solve problems

We also continue to provide Social-Emotional lessons and skills emphasizing the ability to recognize emotions (pleasant/unpleasant, high/low energy) and learn a variety of ways to shift from an emotion if it is not helpful. Our District Teaching and Learning Council is charged with implementing Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports in each building. This includes teaching and reinforcing our Full Value Agreement: Work as a Team, Be Safe, and Speak Up. Ask your child about the Full Value Agreement and consider ways it can be supported at home.
